Opened with Pledge of Allegiance

- Shawn is stepping down as Town Rep for SVAS

Discussion of MOU between town and SVAS

- SVAS would prefer to not give detailed record on ambulance calls due to lack of clarity in some information, but would prefer to give quarterly summaries of service calls, response times, mutual aid coverage etc.
- The BOS reviewed the proposed reports and made small requests for changes.
- The reports will be given monthly as well as including the YTD summaries – the reports will be received by the 10th of each month.
- SVAS was making the appropriate changes to the MOU and will get it to the BOS to be signed.

Old/New Business

- Discussed what the town's responsibility is to its employees if a town employee reports at Covid positive.
 - Contact Tracing will be done, and any impacted employees or citizens will be notified.
 - No other communication is required or necessary.

- - John will verify if Cap Reserve funds can be used to purchase materials etc.


- Shawn did a ride along with Peter Goewey
