

DRAFT MINUTES
CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING
APRIL 8, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m. at the Town Office.

Matt made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 11, 2015 meeting. Bob seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Committee Reports:

Lands: A written legal opinion regarding easements has still not been received from Attorney Hannah.

Members discussed naming the Williston property after Mary Jane Grasty. A trail could be put on the lot. Suggestion was made to provide a parking area that could be used for the Wapack Trail or Mount Watatic. Bob will meet with the Selectmen with the proposal.

The Green Crow property on Binney Hill Road is for sale and well as the land next to the Nussdorfer Nature Area owned by Paul Termin and Ellen Benjamin.

Bob informed the members there is a 33 acre lot off Main Street behind the Barrett Mansion that is for sale. He will contact the owner for more information.

Water resources: David had distributed a draft of the fact sheet on the amendment to the stream buffer, the current ordinance with the proposed changes and a list of affected streams. He asked for comments to be sent to him.

Old Business: A public forum on the proposed gas pipeline was held on March 25. Representative Parison, a member of the SEC, and people opposed to the pipeline were given the opportunity to speak.

Bob had requested from Kinder Morgan a shape file on the pipeline location. He received it but not much information was provided other than the location under the PSNH right-of-way.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 p.m.
