## **Discussion/Action Items:**

Fran wrote letters to the Archambeaults and the Congregational Church inviting them to a
meeting to discuss the Commission's plans for the Old Town Hall and to discuss how their
cooperation will be key to being able to get grants to complete the project. Fran wondered if it
would be worth asking the Archambeaults if they would give us an easement for a well.
A discussion was also had regarding the utilization of a composting toilet or a holding tank. The
fact that Friendship Manor is for sale poses a problem for the Old Town Hall regarding the well
and/or use of water. Debbie will ask the Building Inspector what the options are.
Jason brought up having a fundraiser during the Children's Fair. We could get a porta potty for
that.

Jason pulled the files from the office and the Commission looked over some plans done by Bruce Aho. Phil will reach out to Charlie Saari to see if he would have any interest in restoring the Old Town Hall.

- 2. Phil will scan the architectural assessment from 2007 and send it to Historic New England to see if we can use it to get grants or if we need a new one.
- 3. Fran said she got in touch with Masthof Press. The have everything from Higginsons and could reprint the 1735-1914 Chandler book. She will see if we can get a price for the History of New Ipswich in paperback.
- 4. Jason said Hillsdale College would like some structure and more information to do a speech on the Constitution at the Old Town Hall. Jason will mention it to the Board of Selectmen to get their approval.
