SCHOOL DISTRICT WARRANT ARTICLES

Article 2: 2022-2023 School District Operating Budget

Shall the Mascenic Regional School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling Nineteen Million Four Hundred Seventy-Seven Thousand Six Hundred Ten Dollars (\$19,477,610)? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be Nineteen Million Four Hundred Forty Five Thousand One Hundred Fifty Seven (\$19,445,157) which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Mascenic Regional School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. Majority vote required to pass. The Mascenic Regional School Board unanimously recommends the passage of this article by a vote of 5 to 0. The Mascenic Advisory Budget Committee unanimously recommends the passage of this article by a vote of 5 to 0.

Article 3: Collective Bargaining Agreement

Shall the Mascenic Regional School District approve the cost items included in the three year collective bargaining agreement reached between the Board of the Mascenic Regional School District and the Mascenic Education Association which calls for the following increases in salaries and benefits at the current staffing level:

And further raise and appropriate the sum of Two Hundred Forty Five Thousand Two Hundred Sixty Nine Dollars (\$245,269) for the 2023 fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement over those that would have been paid at the current staffing levels? Majority vote required to pass. The Mascenic Regional School Board recommends the passage of this article by a vote of 3 to 2. The Mascenic Advisory Budget Committee unanimously recommends the passage of this article by a vote of 5 to 0.
