Guide lines for residents

A **Current** Transfer Station Sticker must be attached to the vehicle in a spot that is clearly visible to the Attendants.

A. Household Trash

- 1. There is a fee for Household Trash. the Town sells 2 sizes of bags.
 - a) Large 35 gallon for Trash Cans. \$25 for a roll of 10.
 - b) Small 13 Gallon for Kitchen Trash bins \$12.50 for a roll of 10;
- 2. Bags are sold at the Transfer station and the town hall. It is recommended that you use town bags but if you bring your own bags the fee per bag is
 - a) \$2.50 for a Large
 - b) \$1.50 For a small
- **3.** Residents are responsible for putting their trash in the compactor. If you need help, please ask one of the friendly attendants. They will be happy to help you.

B. Demolition:

There is a Charge for Everything that goes in the Demolition dumpster. The cost is \$30 a cubic yard, you must consult with a transfer station attendant BEFORE you put anything in the demolition dumpster.

C. Recycling:

Please do not sort your recyclables standing in front of the dumpsters

1. Cardboard and Paper:

- a) ALL boxes Must be broken down FLAT and folded if is larger than 3ft.
- b) Residents are responsible for putting the flattened cardboard and paper in to the cardboard dumpster unless otherwise instructed by an attendant.

2. Plastic and Aluminum cans:

- a) Please do not sort your recyclables standing in front of the dumpsters.
- b) All bags MUST be emptied before they are put in to the Plastic / Aluminum dumpster even if the bag is plastic.
- c) Soup and vegetable cans are typically **steel** and need to go to scrap metal **not** the compactor.
- d) Plastic must have a recycling triangle $\stackrel{\frown}{\omega}$ with a number of 7 or less in its center.

D. Electronics:

There is a Charge for all electronics. (computers, monitors, printers, TVs ETC.). Please see an attendant before putting them in the wooden E_Bin.

E. Scrap Metal:

- 1. There is charge for anything that's not 100% metal (i.e. plastic trim etc...)
- 2. please see an attendant before putting things in the scrap meatal pile.

F. Tires

- 1. There is a charge for tires.
- 2. Tires go in to the E-Bin.
